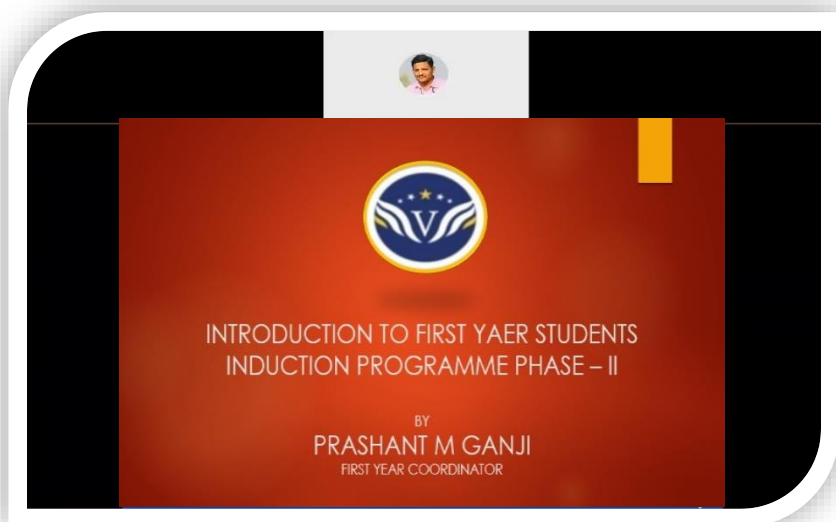
1. Inauguration of Induction Program Phase - II

- ❖ Do's and Don'ts by students with respect to Induction Program.



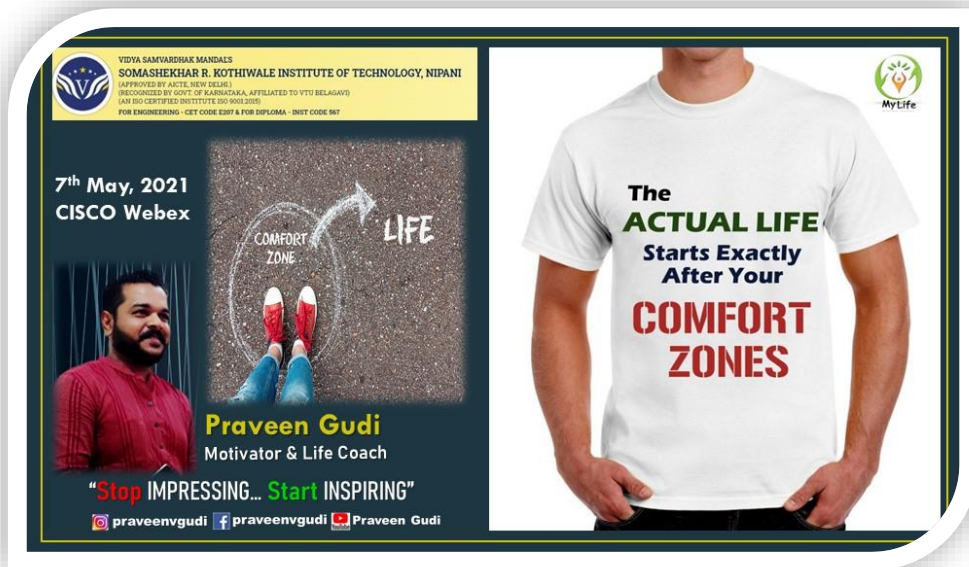

- ❖ Preparation methodology & practices to be followed to get in to a good position in the competitive corporate world.



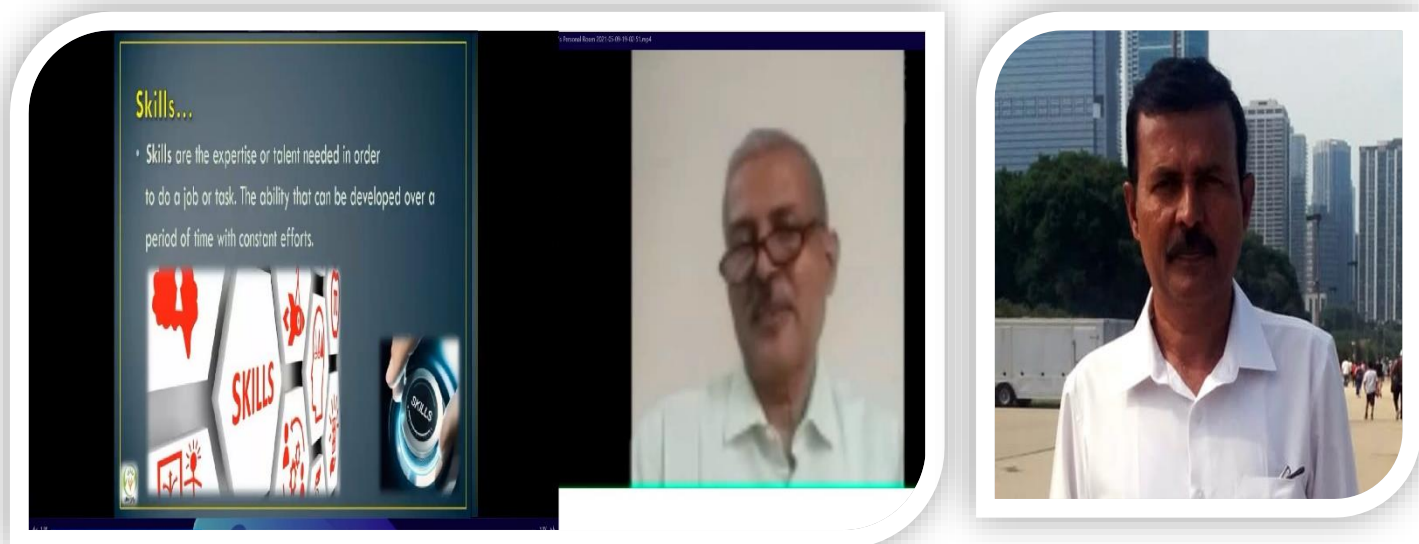

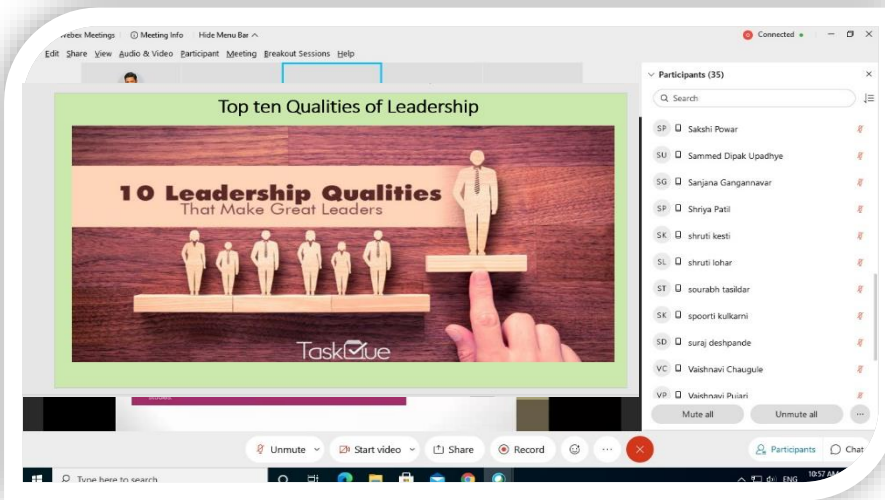

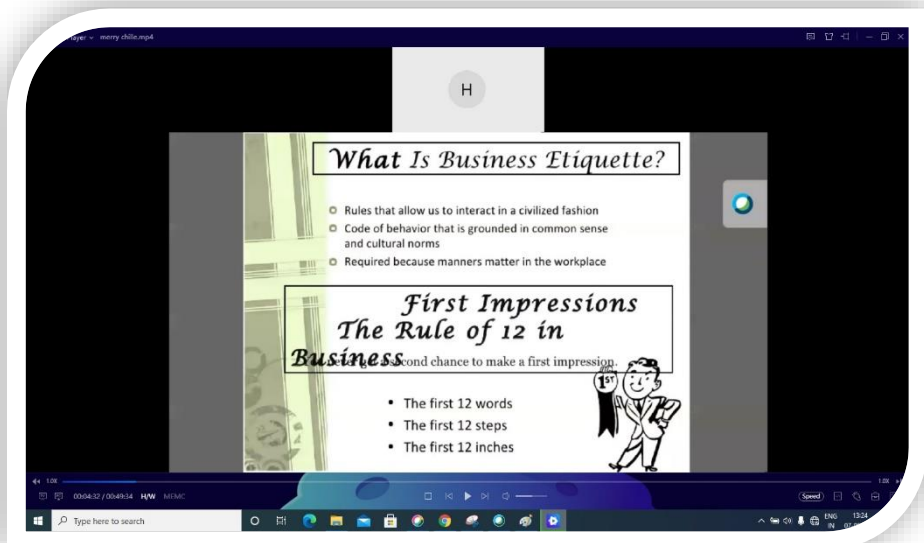
Sir had delivered a webinar on “*Leadership Qualities*”, that included following points

- ❖ Language proficiency while sending emails, rules for sending mass emails.



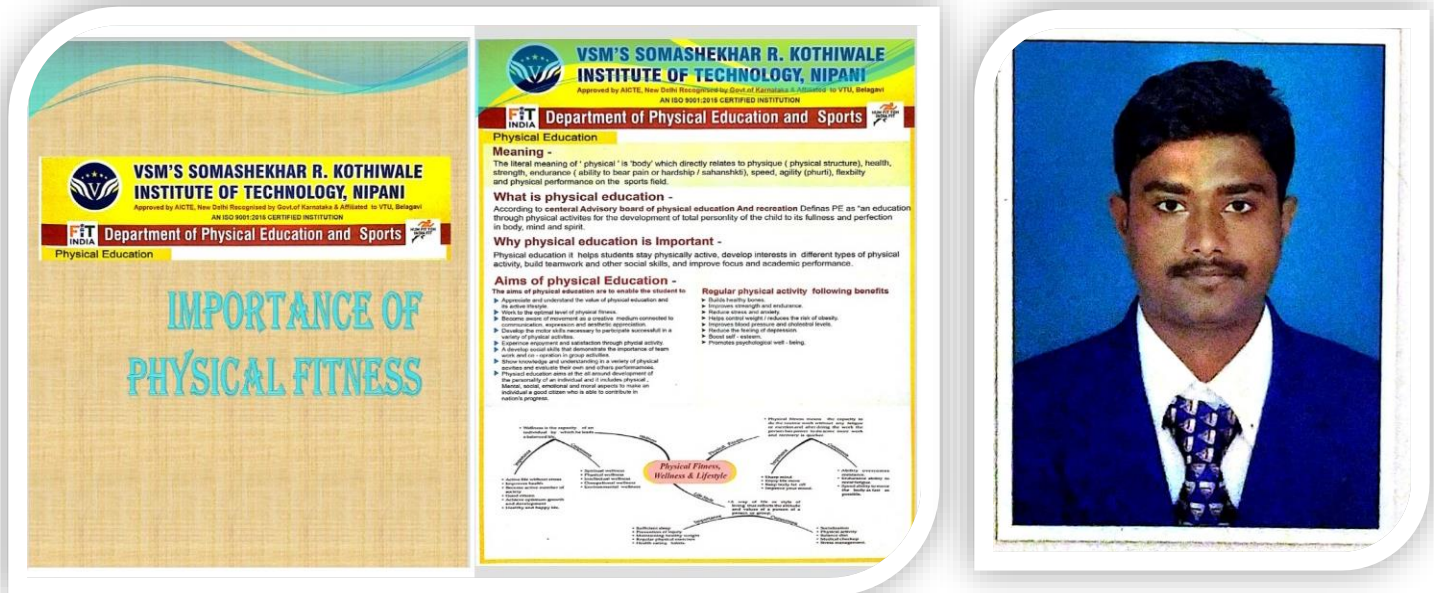

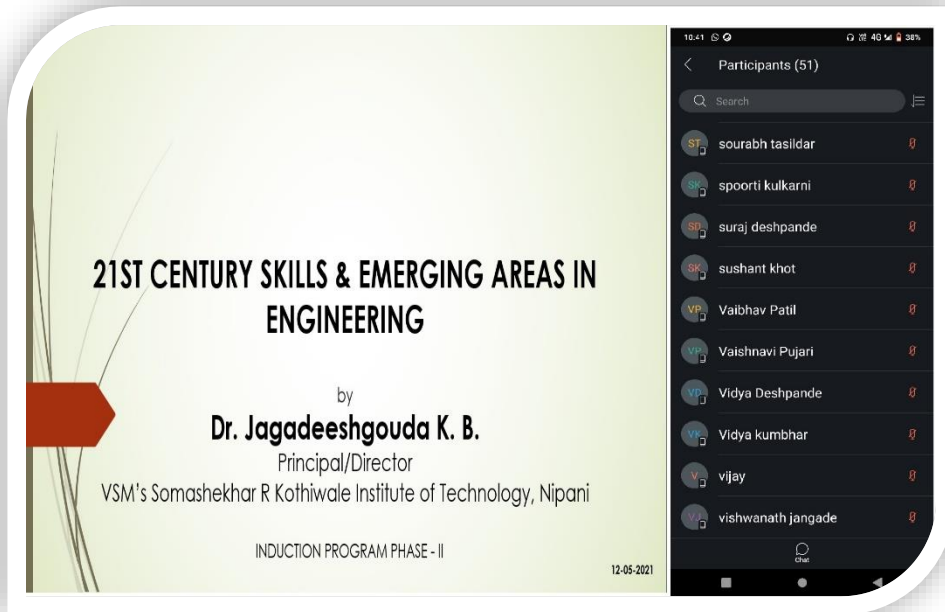

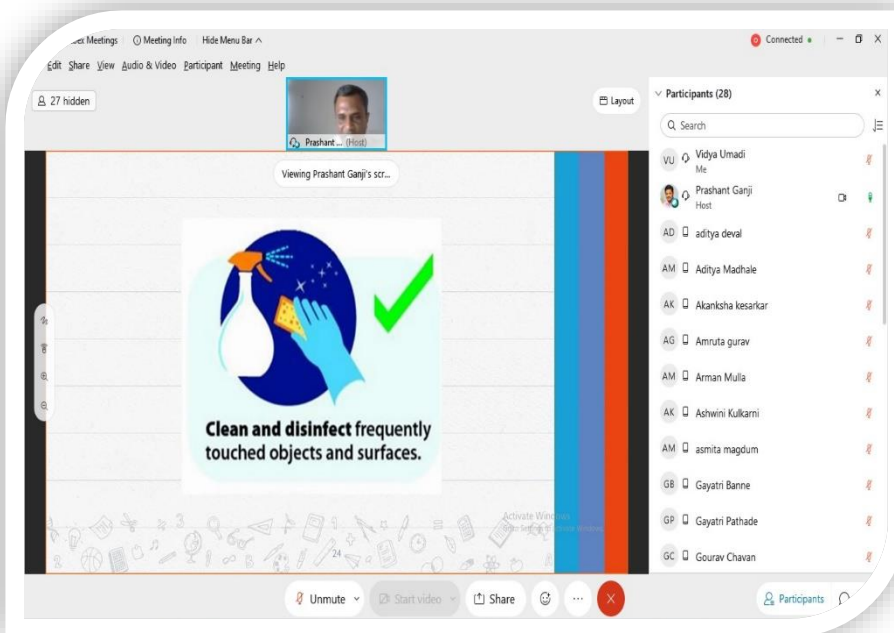
